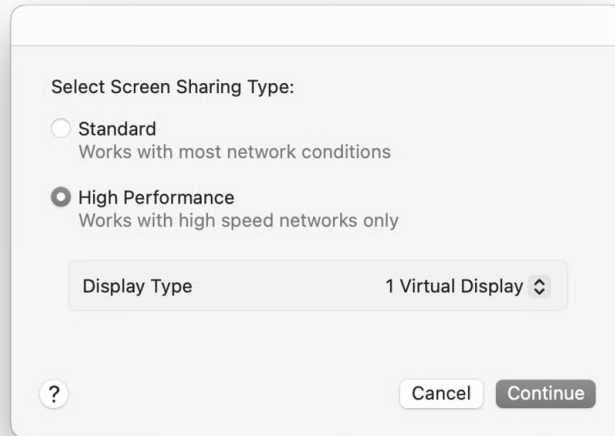




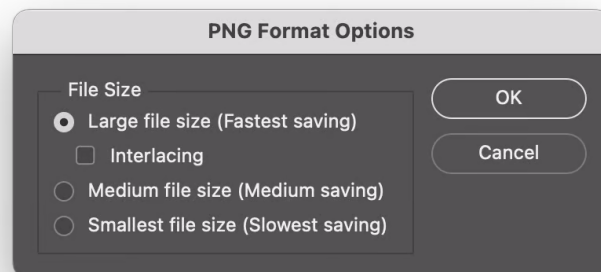
Remember me?
